Dear Parents and Carers,

We hope you all had a lovely Easter break! We are looking forward to a fun-packed Summer Term at Thomas Coram. The children who come here in the holidays were really busy making lots of bird feeders and we have already seen a dramatic increase in the number of birds visiting our garden. The children have been so excited to see the birds eating from our hanging bird feeders that we intend to keep this little project going for everyone to enjoy. To extend this theme further, we will be borrowing some duck eggs and incubators later this term - we will keep you updated as time progresses.

**Time Keeping Reminder-** A fairly small but persistent group of children are regularly arriving late. These children are missing out on their important key-group time. Late arrival is also distracting the teaching team on a daily basis from giving the children who have arrived on time the attention they deserve. The children who arrive late are routinely noted as finding it harder to settle into their day, establish friendships and concentrate on the activities.

For the benefit of everyone, we will be very closely monitoring late arrival this term. This will include asking you to provide a reason for your lateness and signing a 'late-book'- as is common practice in primary schools.
